**If you were notified of a
Data Incident involving The
Urology Center of Colorado
between September 7, 2021
and September 8, 2021, you
may be entitled to benefits
from a settlement.**



A class action settlement has been reached in a lawsuit against The Urology Center of Colorado, P.C. (“TUCC”), arising out of a September 2021 Data Incident that may have resulted in the exposure of your personally identifiable information. You can obtain more information about the settlement or submit a claim online at www.TUCCSettlement.com.

You are receiving this notice because you may be a Settlement Class Member. Under the terms of the settlement, you can recover the following benefits:

Compensation for Documented Ordinary Losses: Compensation for unreimbursed losses, up to a total of \$500 per person, if you submit a Claim Form and supporting documentation for out-of-pocket expenses incurred as a result of the Data Incident.

Compensation for Lost Time: Compensation for up to three hours of time spent dealing with the Data Incident (at \$20 per hour) if you provide an attestation that the lost time was spent responding to issues raised by the Data Incident. You can also submit a claim for up to two additional hours of lost time (at \$20 per hour) by submitting reasonable supporting documentation of the time spent.

Compensation for Documented Extraordinary Losses: If you have documentation showing actual unreimbursed monetary losses as a result of the Data Incident, you may be eligible for reimbursement of up to \$2,500.

California Statutory Payment: If you can confirm that you had a California mailing address at the time of the Data Incident, you can receive an additional \$50 in compensation.

Identity Theft Protection: Enrollment for two (2) years of identity protection services. If you previously enrolled in the IDX identity protection services offered by TUCC in connection with the Data Incident, you will be automatically provided this benefit. If you did not previously enroll in the IDX identity protection services offered by TUCC in connection with the Data Incident, you may submit a claim for this benefit.

The easiest way to submit a claim is online at www.TUCCSettlement.com using your Unique ID found on the front of this postcard. To be eligible, you must complete and submit a valid claim form, postmarked or submitted online on or before **November 7, 2022**. You can also exclude yourself or object to the Settlement on or before **October 10, 2022**. If you do not exclude yourself from the Settlement, you will remain in the Class and will give up the right to sue TUCC for the claims resolved by the Settlement. **A summary of your rights under the Settlement and instructions regarding how to submit a claim, exclude yourself, or object are available at www.TUCCSettlement.com.**

The Court will hold a Final Fairness Hearing on **October 26, 2022, at 1:00 p.m.** At this hearing, the Court will consider whether the Settlement is fair, reasonable, and adequate. The Court will also listen to people who have asked to speak at the hearing. You may attend the Hearing at your own expense, or you may also pay your own lawyer to attend, but it is not necessary.
